Safety & Security

IN CASE OF FIRE



Plan what to do when you check in. You won't have time to plan during a fire.



First, plan two exits nearest your room. If you are on an upper floor, find the nearest stairway. Be sure they are unlocked and unblocked, then count doors between your room and exits so you'll have a reference point if it is smoky.



When you hear an alarm, act, don't investigate. If fire is in your room, get out and close the door. Once out report the fire.



If the fire is not in your room, leave if you can. First, feel your door. If it's cool, open it slowly and go to the nearest exit. Crawl if there is smoke because fresh air will be at the floor. Take your key so you can go back if you can't use your exits.



If your room door is hot DO NOT OPEN IT. Your room may be the safest place to be. Seal all cracks with wet towels. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Signal at your window for help. Call the fire department and wait to be rescued.

SAFETY & SECURITY Continued



Hotels today are special prey for the professional thief. Do not leave cash, credit cards, jewelry, traveler's checks, negotiable securities or other valuables in your room when you are away. No hotel is burglar proof. We cannot assume responsibility for stolen articles. Please follow these simple steps:

Make sure you secure your valuables in a safe location Make sure windows are locked For extra security, use the dead bolt provided on your door. This will prevent the door from being opened by a regular room key. As an additional measure, secure the safety latch. When leaving your room, check to see if your door is closed. Do not admit anyone to your room without first making identification. A peep hole is provided in your door. If there is any question about the person's true identity, contact the front desk.


LIABILITY FOR PROPERTY OF GUESTS.

(1) The hotelkeeper is under no obligation to accept for safekeeping any moneys, securities, jewelry, or precious stones of any kind belonging to any guest, and, if such are accepted for safekeeping, he shall not be liable for the loss thereof unless such loss is the proximate result of fault or negligence of the hotelkeeper. The liability, if any, of the hotelkeeper to a guest shall be limited to one thousand dollars (\$1,000) for such loss, or such higher amount as the hotelkeeper may agree in writing to assume, if the hotel has given a receipt for the property to the guest, stating the value of the property accepted for safekeeping, on a form which states, in type large enough to be clearly noticeable, that the hotel is not liable for any loss exceeding one thousand dollars (\$1,000), or such higher amount as the hotelkeeper may agree in writing to assume, and is only liable for that amount if the loss is the proximate result of fault

or negligence of the hotelkeeper.

(2) The hotelkeeper shall not be liable or responsible to any guest for the loss of wearing apparel, goods, or other property, except as provided in subsection (1) of this section, unless such loss occurred as the proximate result of fault or negligence of such hotelkeeper. In case of such fault or negligence, the hotelkeeper shall not be liable for a sum greater than five hundred dollars (\$500) unless prior to the loss or damage the guest files with the hotelkeeper an inventory of his effects and the value thereof and the hotelkeeper is given the opportunity to inspect such effects and check them against such inventory. The hotelkeeper shall not be liable or responsible to any guest for the loss of effects listed in such inventory in a total amount exceeding one thousand dollars (\$1,000) or such higher amount as the hotelkeeper may agree in writing to assume.

Meadow Creek Golf Course has 18 holes, 18 minutes north of McCall. Call 208-347-2555 for tee times.


Jug Mountain Ranch is an 18 hole Championship Golf Course, located just 15 minutes south of McCall. Call 208-634-5072 for a tee time.
